We are cooperating with the local medical authorities through our School Doctor and we have made the Medical Centre available as an overflow facility if it is needed.


Our Medical Centre was opened in 2018 and is very well equipped, offering a valuable resource for the authorities if the need arises.

Fresh food is already on order for next term and we are collaborating with suppliers and local charities to redistribute the food intended for our pupils to those who are isolated and unable to get to the supermarkets. As we purchase food in bulk, we are able to put food packs together at a competitive price. The intention is to sell these packs at a small mark up to those who can afford it and then to use that premium to allow us to donate free food packs to CHAT – a local charity who help the homeless and with whom we have a long standing relationship.
